From Libby

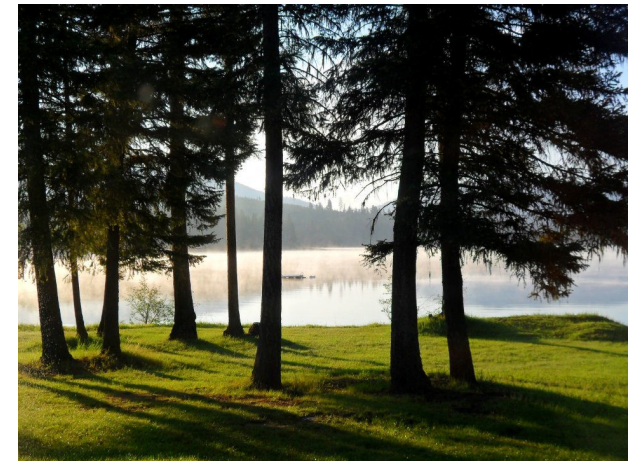
