How to Donate

Bring donations to the EBC gym on Tuesday and Wednesday, August 9 & 10, from 9am-7pm and Thursday, August 11, from 9am-4pm. Items too large to bring? Schedule furniture or appliance pick-up by calling Frank Shelt at (520) 275-1935 or Karen Shelt at (520) 360-7152.

What to Donate

Furniture, appliances and exercise equipment:

Large and small appliances need to be in good working order and clean. Include manuals and instructions if possible. Sporting goods should have all their parts. Upholstered furniture should not be stained or torn. *No waterbeds.*

Hardware and Electronics:

Hardware and electronics should be in good working order and may include: TVs, radios and telephones, recent computers and laptops, office equipment and supplies, DVD/VCRs, stereo components and personal music devices with all their parts, garden and shop tools and power tools. Include manuals and instructions if possible. Cords must be taped or rubber banded to electronic items. *No old. outdated computers or TVs.*

Miscellaneous household items:

May include: dishes and kitchenware, kitchen utensils, lamps and lights, pictures and frames, mirrors and candlesticks, luggage, holiday items and decorations. Please no partly burned candles. We cannot accept open cosmetics, lotions, or perfumes. Please no food or pet food.

Jewelry:

May include: costume jewelry, precious and semi-precious stones, metals, beadwork, fashion jewelry, antique and contemporary jewelry. Please box, wrap or use baggies to prevent breakage/loss. Mark/describe if you know what it is or how old it is.

Clothing, shoes and accessories:

All sizes and styles are accepted, but please nothing torn or stained. Purses, backpacks, beach bags are also accepted. We *DO* accept bras and swim wear. We *DO NOT* accept underpants.

Children's items:

May include: clean clothing, shoes, purses and dress-up clothes, gently used baby furniture, strollers, high chairs, lamps, bedding, decorations, books, games (complete), puzzles (no pieces missing), DVDs, CDs, outdoor sports equipment, bats, mitts, skates, blades, protective gear, backpacks, dolls, doll clothes, stuffed animals, cars, trucks and miscellaneous toys. *No car seats please*.

Linens. decorations and crafts:

May include: sheets (mark sizes), blankets, comforters, curtains, drapes (mark sizes), window treatments (in original boxes please), towels (no fraying or holes), plastic baskets, fake flowers or plants, plastic vases, canning jars, and paper holiday decorations.

Books and magazines:

May include: hardcover/paperback books, Christian books, secular fiction, nonfiction, collections, magazines about crafts, cooking, needlework, woodworking and other hobbies, DVDs, CDs, books on tape, videos, and cassettes. *Please no encyclopedias, textbooks, phone books, water-damaged books, National Geographic, or home-copied videos or cassettes.*
