GUEST SPEAKER ON SEPTEMBER 4:BARRETT DUKE, PH.D

What would a Christian say about our nation today? Find out on Sunday, September 4th. Vice President for Public Policy and Research, and Director of the Research Institute of The Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention, Barrett Duke, is coming to speak at our Sunday services.



As Vice President for Public Policy and Research, Barrett directs the work of the ERLC's advocacy arm in Washington, DC. In this capacity, he communicates Southern Baptist convictions to elected and public officials in order to influence the development of sound public policy. As Director of the Commission's Research Institute, Barrett oversees the Commission's research and the collection of information on the pressing moral and religious liberty issues of the day.

Barrett has worked with legislators and various government agencies on many legislative and public policy issues, including abortion, euthanasia, gambling, homosexuality, immigration reform, judicial nominations, pornography, public education, religious liberty, same-sex marriage, sex trafficking, stem cell research, and substance abuse. He has testified during hearings of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms and before the U.S. House of Representatives Subcommittee on Immigration and Border Security. He speaks regularly on Christian worldview, sanctity of human life, gambling, homosexuality, capital punishment, public education, religious freedom, separation of church and state, and other issues in many religious and civic settings.

Barrett received the BA degree, with a major in Bible, in 1982 from the Criswell College in Dallas, Texas. During his years at the Criswell College, he served as Student Body Vice President and President. He received the MA degree in Old Testament Studies in 1985 from Denver Conservative Baptist Seminary in Denver, Colorado. While at Denver Seminary, he participated in a three week study tour of Israel at the Institute of Holy Land Studies in Jerusalem, Israel. In 1999, he received the Ph.D. in Religious and Theological Studies from the joint doctoral program of the Iliff School of Theology and the University of Denver.

Prior to his current position, Barrett was the founding pastor of Cornerstone Church in a suburb of Denver, Colorado, from 1984 to 1996, leading a small home Bible study group of 13 people to organize as a church of nearly 200. In addition, he led the congregation to purchase eight acres of land and build a first phase church building in a growing suburb of Denver. Barrett especially enjoys helping Christians to connect God's Word with their lives and assisting churches to bring God's love in Jesus and His truth to their communities.
