SEPTEMBER 19

"I am here to update you again on my experience at YWAM. The last three months have been life changing. The Lord has helped me break out of my shell and has equipped me to share the Good News with others. This Sunday, September 25th, I will be heading to Seattle, then Hong Kong, and landing in "N" (shortened for security reasons). We will be in "N" until Thanksgiving doing Bible distribution, project rebuilding, and sharing the Gospel to an unreached people group. I so appreciate your prayers as God continues to lead me on this journey."

OCTOBER 1

"Miss ya like crazy! Today, I was at a church here in "K". It was unreal to see people halfway around the world in their own language and style praising and worshiping God. It's been good so far. It's very "third worldish" so the sights, smells, and sounds take time getting used to. We also did street evangelism yesterday and that was tough. Stepping out and telling a stranger in "H" about Christ is a real challenge, but God is always there beside me. Thanks for all your prayers. We leave for "G" tomorrow to do Bible distribution for three weeks."
