Assisting Church Planting by teaching missionary kids in Papua New Guinea

"Teachers know *that moment*. Your administrator hands you a projected class list and then the inventory list. It is time to take stock in what you have and predict what you might need to order to be fully prepared for the next year. By the time we order and ship the items to those who will load them on a container, and receive them here in country, the next school year will be already be upon us. As part of that process of preparing for the next school year, we look around, wonder, and pray for who will be teaching. Currently, in the elementary, we are sufficiently staffed, but since some teachers are only here short term and others will be going on a time of home assignment, we will be insufficiently staffed next year. Of the present 13 teachers, only two are full time teachers; the rest are filling in while holding other ministries in other departments or at home.

Do you see why we are starting now to prayerfully and intentionally recruit teachers for next year? Will you pray for those who will come and teach? Pray for faith as we watch how God will provide. Recently, my heart is burdened for my 6th grade students to have a deeper knowledge of God. I want them to know God has a purpose for their lives, and that they would desire to do all they can to prepare themselves to fulfill that purpose. I want them to fall deeper in love with Christ each day. Please join me in that prayer."
