A Supreme Decision *By Franklin Graham*

'In many ways, the 2016 presidential election is not about the personalities running or the parties they represent—it's about the judges they will appoint. The next president will choose judges for the Supreme Court and for federal courts who will largely determine which version of the American future the nation gets: a secular-progressive version hostile to Biblical Christianity, or one friendly to religious liberty and the sanctity of human life. Every president since Ronald Reagan has appointed two Supreme Court justices. President Obama appointed two, Sonia Sotomayor and Elena Kagan, who voted for gay marriage by judicial fiat. On November 8, the stakes get higher: the next president could appoint up to four justices. The fate of America is increasingly tied to sweeping Supreme Court rulings. Beyond the Supreme Court, the past three presidents have each **appointed more than 300 federal district and circuit court judges**. Some of those same judges are the ones who have ruled mercilessly against Christian bakers, florists, photographers, and others who have revisited servicing homosexual weddings as a matter of Christian conscience.

In voting on November 8, remember the impact federal courts can have on fundamental religious freedoms of Christians, and how your vote will affect the future of Gospel proclamation in America for generations. Nearly 30 million evangelicals failed to make their way to the voting booth in the last election cycle. We must not repeat that mistake again this November."
