"We have had a busy, but fun month of October. Our classes were challenging and encouraging and Grandma and Grandpa Moser visited!! In school, we just finished Proverbs, Joshua, and Judges. Jake also took a class on the origin of sin. We had an opportunity to hear an amazing couple from Papa New Guinea speak on their experience over the last two years learning culture and language in a tribe so that they can plant a church. It was such an encouragement to hear their story and see how God was working in their tribe. It gave us a small glimpse of what we might be doing in the near future. There are several ways we need your partnership in prayer: It has been setting in for us that this distance away from family and friends is going to be our new normal. It has gotten harder for us as we think about all the little or big things we are missing out on because of being here. Pray for us to keep things in the proper perspective as we continue our training. Katie has also had some significant dental work done...a couple of root canals and one because of infection to the tune of \$1,800. If God places it on your heart, we could use some help with this unexpected bill. Please also pray that God will provide us with the right future partners in ministry.

New Tribes Mission requires their missionaries to have a sending church. We are so thankful for the hearts of the people at Easthaven who are partnering with us. Your role is just as important to help the spread of the gospel! We want you all to know we are praying for you, and are so thankful to have you as part of our team! We love you, and look forward to seeing so many of you over Christmas break!"




