"Most of this year has been spent debriefing people who are working or have been working in the Middle East, which has been a part of the world that we have not touched through Emmaus Encounter until this year. Asia, Haiti, Latin America, and the United States continue to be locations we serve. Each one has been special, unique, and a great opportunity to serve those who are serving others in some pretty tough places. We are thankful and have the inner peace and joy that comes with knowing that we have taken the right path for this season in our lives. We both know that this is what God has invited us to do at this time. We also spent this summer exploring what it might look like to start providing accommodations for those who are debriefed. We spent some time in the spring doing some 'light remodeling' to our basement and turned it into a cozy apartment. During the summer, we hosted three very low maintenance couples. While it was doable for them, we realized that we need to be able to have time and space apart from those to whom we minister. This has led us to start looking at another living scenario that will give us the ability to provide a separate location for those who are debriefed. YWAM continues to allow us to house people there, but there are seasons when they don't have any room available. We have started looking at land and at the possibility of selling our home, to downsize our personal home and to build a cabin for those who are being debriefed. **Would you be in prayer with us as we seek God's will in all of this?** It is not exactly what we had thought we would be looking at when we originally moved here to Montana. However, God has a way of keeping us on our toes! We believe this is our next step. We are walking in God's grace.
