South Asia Report Fishers of Men

"This year, 350 members of the fishermen community received training in the gospel from Creation to Christ. These people are now sharing the good news with others. God is at work in the 300 villages that were visited. There has only been three or four places of opposition as 60,000 booklets were distributed. The community received three donated motor boats, a van, and 24 bore wells. Other churches besides Easthaven have also partnered with this group.

There are now six full-time workers leading house churches. Many have been baptized and more are ready. The fishermen identify with Simon Peter. They love the story found in Luke 5, the choosing of the disciples and also in John 6 where Jesus gave a meal of bread and fish to the 5,000. In this country, where vegetarians are considered purely spiritual, fishermen can take comfort in a gospel that includes them.

By the middle of December, we hope to have reached out to 14,000 children in this community. Each child will receive a gift from us including a picture Bible, a notebook, a Christian comic book, and sweets. So far, we have seen a fantastic response to the Bible stories that they learned."
