## South Asia Report

### *Adopted People Group*

“Today there are ten full-time workers among this group. Many have been baptized and more are interested.

We are working with college students. Recently, six of them finished post-graduate studies while another 125 are doing graduate studies. This is unusual for this tribe that has a 3-5% literacy rate. The students are sharing the gospel with their peers. Classmates noticed a change in the girls, and they wanted to know what it was. The girls brought seven friends to the meeting. These friends, in turn, accepted Christ as their Savior. We have heard many testimonies of God’s faithfulness in this tribe.

Many of the college students go home for the weekend and help clean their village and conduct de-addiction programs.

Please pray for those husbands who have two or three wives and take no responsibility for their children. Many women resort to begging, finding it easier than going to work. Students from this tribe want transformation in their communities and believe that it can only come through Jesus Christ.”
