A Declaration for Victory in the New Year

A common misconception about faith is that God asks us to approach it blindly. Accordingly, many believe the pinnacle of belief is to trust God without the need of evidence.

To make such an assertion, we often look to models in 'faith's hall of fame." It's thought that Noah 'blindly' followed God to prepare for something never before seen. Abraham 'blindly' obeyed God to nearly sacrifice his only son Isaac. Or that David 'blindly' ran to that battle line to face Goliath.

Though the faith of many throughout the Bible is exemplary, it's not blind. None of them acted only because a voice instructed them to do something. *No, they all built their confidence and trust to obey God's difficult orders because of their histories with Him.* Noah was known as one who walked closely with God, and he was hundreds of years old when God asked him to build the ark. During that time, Noah shared a rich history with God, who had proven faithful time and time again. Over time, Abraham came to know the Lord intimately as a promise keeper.
