Praying for the Peace of Jerusalem

The following is a report of the importance of praying for the peace of Jerusalem.

On Sunday, January 15, a conference was held in Paris with 70 nations attending for the purpose of formulating a declaration devoted to dividing up the covenant land of Israel and Jerusalem. (A so-called peace accord without Israel even in attendance.) This follows on the heels of the UN resolution in December where the USA failed to veto or stand with Israel over another anti-Israel vote.

The Paris document was to determine that Israel and Palestine would be two separate states, going back to pre-1967 borders. When translated, Israel does not own the Wailing Wall, the Temple Mount, a single inch of the West Bank, or a single inch of East Jerusalem. There is much more to this initiative, but the bottom line is anti-Semitic. Joel 3:1-2 warns, *"In those days at that time, when I restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem, I will gather all the nations, and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. I will enter into judgment with them there regarding My people and My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations; they have also divided up My land."* Those that bless Israel will be blessed and those that curse her will be cursed.

BUT GOD heard the prayers of His people. Attempts to formulate a declaration devoted to dividing up the covenant land came into confusion. At one point during the deliberations, 'there was complete chaos over the phrasing of the statement.' In the end, the conference appears to have accomplished few, if any of its original goals. **Prayer can change the course of history!**
