Teaching Your Family the Power of Prayer

One of the primary roles of parents and grandparents is to leave a spiritual legacy to their family. What better legacy than a good prayer life? Give them an unconquerable faith, an unstoppable drive, and an insatiable passion to serve Jesus Christ. Give them a God legacy!

The apostle Paul had to point out Timothy's spiritual legacy. *"I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also."* (2 Tim 1:5) Timothy became the recipient of a transgenerational legacy. Two generations of praying women shaped him from the inside out. Their behavior shaped his. The stark reality is you cannot take someone where you've never been yourself. To raise praying children means that you must first have a measure of proficiency yourself.

Susanna Wesley, the mother of John and Charles Wesley—founding brothers of the Methodist Church—had nineteen children. Seldom did she miss a daily hour of prayer. She had no private room nor dedicated space to seek the Lord. Yet that didn't stop her. She would take her apron and pull it over her face. Her children were instructed never to disturb 'mother' when she was praying in her apron. The sight of a praying parent leaves a huge impression on the soul of a child. It trumps any verbal instruction that you'll ever give to your little one on prayer.

Admittedly we're living in a different era, but as Christians we should never veer from this parental target: *'Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.'* (Prov. 22:6) We cannot cave in to popular culture that suggests that we leave our children to form their own opinions about God, faith, or prayer. You don't have to be a perfect parent, but be a praying parent! God's involvement with the rearing of your child will fill in the parenting gaps that you were unable to perform.
