The Responsibility of a Praying Parent

No one can guide a child's spiritual growth but the parent. Though many parents expect the church to assume total responsibility for the spiritual development of their children, the fact is that is not the church's job! The church supplements, but doesn't replace, home training. It comes alongside of parents to reinforce and undergird their efforts, but it is the parents that must take the lead in the spiritual development of their child's prayer life.

In his book *The Forgotten Ways* Alan Hirsch writes: "Take the Chinese (underground church) ...when most of their leaders and theologians (have been) killed or imprisoned and all access to outside sources is cut off, they are somehow forced through sheer circumstances to unlock something truly potent and compelling in the message they carry as the people of God." What Dr. Hirsch is pointing out is that the Chinese Christians were forced to take responsibility for their spiritual formation instead of placing it on the shoulders of the organized church. The pastors could not assume the sole responsibility of being 'the keepers of God's spiritual secrets.' The entire church had to know how to pray and train one another in the art of prayer. Consequently, the underground church of China numbers in the millions. And is quite strong in prayer and other disciplines.

Parents are the principal prayer-trainer for their children.
