## Carmen Devries-Papua New Guinea Teaching 6th grade missionary kids

"Praise the Lord for a recent outreach. The entire village attended all the lessons. . . about 250 people in all. In the follow-up teaching over the coming days, it will become more clear where individual people stand. However, there have been encouraging testimonies of people repenting & trusting in Christ alone!

One testimony: 'In the past, I always heard things from religious groups out there, and saw the images of Jesus on a cross, but I had no idea what that meant, what His death meant, why He was killed, and what killing Him meant. Now today I understand, I've heard what it means. I understand that He died covered in our sins. He had no sin of His own, and because of that He could be like a perfect sheep for sacrifice."

The school term ends soon, and break begins. One main event of break is conference for missionaries in the different regions of PNG. Conference is a time when all the missionaries in bush locations come together for a 'family reunion' of sorts. It is a time of teaching, a time of sharing, and some time for laughs.

Pray for safe travels, team unity, good ministry opportunities, and sweet fellowship for the missionaries and a team from the States. They are only on the ground a short time, but I pray it will be a meaningful experience for them and an encouraging time as they pour into the kids.

Pray for teachers for our school. Time is short for any wanting to make it before the next school year. We need teachers in both elementary and high school.

Pray that I may keep my focus on God. I can easily get distracted by circumstances."
