Update on Mission to Czech Republic

Last week (March 25–April 1) Darla Meadors and Jessica Nosstrum visited our partner church in the Czech Republic promoting the summer English camp that our team will lead.

Their week included visiting different schools in Vysoke Myto to meet new students and their teachers, making new contacts and letting others in town know that the church 'exists' and has some good things to offer. Afternoon and evening activities included a camp meeting at the church, an evening English class, open home groups (both in Vysoke Myto and Hradec Kralove) and a youth meeting. These meetings were geared for people who do not go to church and do not know Jesus personally. **Pray that the contacts that were made will lead to people coming to faith.**

Some good news from Vysoke Myto Baptist Church: "Radim, who was at the camp for the first time in 2016, started going to our worship services almost regularly after EBC's Julie Early and Venus Stoner visited us in November. Zdenek invited him for a small Bible group and he accepted. God has been talking to him and he also prayed and expressed he had already made a decision for Jesus!! Pray for him, please!! He keeps coming to Vysoke Myto twice a week-Sundays and for a small group on Wednesdays to discuss the Bible. He's in touch with a couple of men from church. Let's pray for him, his family and his decision to be confirmed by baptism. Renata and her two small children were with him at the camp, but she does not seem to be very open to God yet. We pray for her too."


