# **Prayer Request for South Asia Partner**

Our South Asia partner has sent an urgent prayer request.

For the past nine years, our partner has been invited to speak at a large religious sect's annual conference. They specifically asked our partner to speak about Jesus. Two years ago our partner printed a little booklet that included his speech, and it was intended to bridge their beliefs to Christian beliefs. One of the organizers was the chairperson of the conference, but he arrived at the end of the program after the booklets were distributed. Two years later this person pulled out his booklet and made claims that our partner is using the book for conversion purposes. He has complained to the district government official and district police and demanded our partner's arrest and a ban on the booklet. He has given a statement to 9 newspapers and several television channels. He has also raised a guestion in the state Legislature Assembly-all part of a plan to create problems for Christians. Pray for wisdom and guidance, as well as protection for family, staff and leaders of our partner's team, and for the Gospel to advance in spite of the opposition.

## **Prayer Request from Czech Republic**

Dave Birkett, an Australian married to a Czech woman, attended the English camp last year. After the English camp he started coming to the worship services along with regular Bible studies with Zdenek. He is a Christian, and he gives testimonies about his faith in Jesus even to his doctors. He had a hip replacement on March 24. **Pray for a quick recovery**. **Pray for his wife who is not a believer, and has never come to church. People from the church are in touch with Dave and his wife, and are seeing an increased deepening of interest.**
