Wolfe's Report

Europe: Mobilizing workers to make disciples in a spiritually dark and post Christian context.

“Thanks for your prayers during our time abroad. We were blessed by the opportunity to come alongside fellow workers in this region of the world. For our family, it was a time of refreshment, encouragement, and excitement about the future! We were able to serve our teams in Europe for seven days by listening to their stories of what God is doing, helping to mobilize more workers to their teams, and praying for them. It was amazing to hear how God is working and moving all throughout Europe!

A few highlights:

- Zach and Vera each had their own trips to the hospital in Hungary. Zach twisted his ankle badly. It is not broken, but ligaments were damaged and is now in an air cast. Vera was bitten by a dog and needed a tetanus shot. Both are doing well now!
- We met with over 20 different Pioneers Teams in Europe to help them in mobilizing workers for their teams and areas.
- We were able to share the Gospel with several local Hungarians and international students in Budapest.
- We spent time with amazing workers for Christ and built new friendships.
