“Katie and I had a chance to go to a place called Wayumi with other students during our spring break. It is a camp that New Tribes has set up to give people a taste of what a tribal culture and the church planting processes are really like. The missionaries who run the camp have spent years in a tribe where they learned the language and culture and planted churches. One of the exciting things that we were introduced to was how to learn an undocumented language. We encountered tribes each with their own personality. Some were very shy while others were aggressive and ridiculed us. Overall, it gave us the big-picture of what the process of church planting looks like.

I cannot adequately put into words what an incredible privilege it has been to be here at New Tribes Bible School learning more about our Savior. I’m already looking forward to all the classes next year.
