Praying for the Peace of Jerusalem

May is a significant month for the state of Israel. They will be celebrating 70 years since becoming a nation and 50 years since Jerusalem was united under Jewish rule for the first time in over 2,400 years with the Six Day War in 1967. President Trump will be in Jerusalem for two days before that celebration.

Prayer points for his visit:

- Great wisdom would be released to Mr. Trump and his advisors during meetings
- · For protection and discernment for security
- He would experience a meeting with the God of Israel while there
- He would be humble where necessary, and not to presume himself capable of solving the difficult and complex difficulties of Israel, Judea, and Samaria alone. We pray that he would allow God to use him and the country he represents in His way in bringing peace to the Middle East.
- Pray for the end of a four year drought. Water levels in the Sea of Galilee are the lowest ever leading to an increase in the salt levels, which make the water unusable for irrigation.
