“The next South Asia team leaves June 19. Praise God, we have seen kingdom advance from every trip. Hundreds of people have come to know Christ and many have been baptized. On this trip, we hope to spend more time with the 60 leaders God has raised up. We would like to cast the vision for them of God’s heart to reach their own people (approx. 400,000 from the two people groups we work with). We plan to share Jesus’ strategy for reaching people from Luke 10. We also want to share the key principles for making disciples and planting churches in reproducible cycles. This is a God-sized task. We don’t stand a chance unless you join us in prayer. We represent EBC, and you can be a part of the team through praying for us or sending us.
