Zach & Carrie Wolfe: Pioneers Ministry

"We recently had a conversation with a Japanese women. Zach posed the question, "Has anyone ever shared the Gospel with you?" Her response was, "No." Zach's follow up, "Would you be willing to allow me to share this wonderful message with you?" Her response was, "No." What struck us about this conversation was not that the woman did not want to hear the Gospel, but that she has lived in the U.S. for eight years and had never heard the Gospel. 90% of American Christians only experience hearing the Gospel at church. This means we are not sharing the Gospel outside of our church. Our prayer is that this cultural American norm would be broken and that the Good news would be heard at a park, at work, and at school in our every day living."
