2017 NOMINATING COMMITTEE BALLOT

Each summer a leadership ballot for the following year is prepared by the Nominating Committee and presented to the congregation for a vote. This year the church body will elect *three* additional church members to serve on the Nominating Committee. The normal term is a period of three years. Once all ballots have been received, the persons receiving the most votes will be contacted and asked if they would be willing to serve on this committee.

The responsibilities of this committee are to prayerfully offer leadership opportunities to the membership of the church so that they can exercise their spiritual gifts within the ministries of the church. The ideal candidates are people who understand the mission of the church, know people, and are not afraid to ask people to serve in the ways that God has gifted them.
