Teaching Our Children to Pray

Children often learn important concepts and valuable habits through fun activities. Prayer can be introduced the same way.

Text a Prayer

Your child's era is a social media one. In order for prayer to be meaningful and relevant, we must show them how it fits into their world. Consider having them use your phone to send a prayer text to a relative. For example:

- **Christian relative:** "Hi, Grandma. This morning I prayed for you by asking, 'Heavenly Father, help Grandma to not be lonely, but to have a lot of good friends and for our relationship to become stronger.' I can't wait to see you!"
- **A non-Christian relative:** 'Hi, Grandma. This morning I prayed for you by asking, 'Loving God, help Grandma to experience Your love in a greater way. Please answer all of her spiritual questions and bless her in a big way. I ask You this in the name of my Savior, Jesus. Amen.' I love you, Grandma. See you soon!"

Make recommendations regarding purchase, sale, and upkeep of property. Receive and act on requests for facility maintenance, repairs, and alterations.

Fellowship Committee _____

Provide guidance in the maintenance, administration, and use of the fellowship and kitchen facilities. Plans and supervises fellowship activities, potlucks, meals, coffee service.

Missions Committee—International _____

Provide general guidance to the missions program of the church—in U.S. and overseas. Recommends to the church how to allocate Missions budget.

Missions Committee—North American _____

Responsible for working with staff to help our church engage in local endeavors such as: local church starts, community projects, and local and state-wide outreach.

Personnel Committee _____

Responsible to recommend additional staff positions, update job descriptions & organization charts, recruit, interview, and recommend prospective staff.

Stewardship Committee _____

Receive, review, and approve requests for budget funds from other committees, staff members, and organizations and compile recommended annual budget.

Care Ministry Team _____

Responsible for administering the Shepherd Shelves and handling requests for financial assistance made to the church by needy parties. Coordinates the church's involvement with community outreach ministries such as Feeding the Flathead and Habitat for Humanity.

Decor Ministry Team _____

Arrange and decorate the church as needed.

Funeral Ministry Team _____

Organize resources to support church family funerals. Plans refreshments, organizes volunteers, prepares facility, etc.

Men's Ministry Team _____

Provide guidance to all men's ministry activities including organizing, coordinating, planning, etc. Organizes volunteers and works with other ministries to make sure activities and events serve intended purpose.

Women's Ministry Team _____

Provide guidance to all women's ministry activities including organizing, coordinating, planning, etc. Organizes volunteers and works with other ministries to make sure activities and events serve intended purpose.

Welcome Ministry Team _____

Organize and guide greeters and activities related to outreach follow- up for visitors. This includes delivery of welcome (brownie) packets, follow-up calls, etc.
