Report from Northern Lights

“On a follow-up visit to a family, we met a man who asked us to visit another family with a sick daughter several miles in the desert. After driving through the sand and barren land, the low tents emerged on the horizon. The black exterior of the tent gave way to colorful carpets and pillows inside. After our eyes adjusted, we could clearly see that the teenaged girl was very troubled. She kept her gaze on her hands twisted in her lap and would not make eye contact with anyone. As we asked questions, she answered in barely a breath and we struggled to hear what she was saying. Her mother answered most of the questions for her. As the men of the family were looking on, we took her to the women’s side of the tent and still tried to understand the issues, as all her vital signs were normal and she seemed healthy. We knew that the origin of her problems was external. My teammate tried to distract the other family members while I hurriedly whispered to the girl, trying to share hope. I assured her that God sees her and cares about her, and that she can ask Him to show her truth. She finally looked at me in the face and smiled. We ended the visit with a promise to return again. Later we learned the girl’s story. Her father wanted her to marry a cousin and she refused. He put a loaded gun to her head until she finally agreed. But the cousin, hearing of her initial refusal, backed out of the marriage arrangement. Now the young woman is shamed and potentially not marriageable. At seventeen years of age, she has no hope for the future and a father who threatens to kill her for the sake of the family honor. This family desperately needs to know the hope, love, and peace that are free to anyone who asks. **Please pray that when we visit the family again, we would be able to share the full message of New Life and that they would believe and receive.”**
