Dear Church Family,

As we launch into 2017, we have so much to be thankful for over this past year. In case you missed the "State of the Church" address, let me recap a few of the most significant highlights of 2016:

- 16% growth in our weekend worship service attendance, with the addition of 7:45am service
- 11:1 member to baptism ratio (total of 69 baptisms)
- 17% growth in general receipts to the church's operating budget
- Approximately 43% of our church membership is volunteering in ministry
- Completion of Phases 1 & 2 of Building for the Journey
- Members from Easthaven served in International Missions (India, Czech Republic, Cambodia, Germany, Turkey, China, Nepal, Uganda, Indonesia, Papua New Guinea, Jordan)
- Members from EBC served in North American Missions (Heart Butte with four total trips, Spokane, Lake Tahoe, Indianapolis, Portland, New York City to explore an outreach to Jews)
- Launch of Summit Life Church, Whitefish with an average attendance of 53 in the first four months
- Church Plant team on field in Columbia Falls
- 19% growth in camper days at TLC Retreat with many improvements

Every so often you just have one of those years when the blessings and grace of God are almost overwhelming. This has certainly been one of those years. The goodness of God is evidenced everywhere and now we are responsible to steward even more for His Kingdom. So what are we striving to accomplish in 2017? Even more!

- Glacier Bible College capital fundraising and campus development launch
- Phase 3 of Building for the Journey capital fundraising
- Continued growth and development of TLC Retreat

And on a personal note, it is certainly worth noting that our four most-tenured pastors have 65 years of ministry service between us here at Easthaven. I do not know of another church with that kind of consistency and longevity of service together. It is my great privilege to serve with everyone on our staff. 25 YEARS OF MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS PASTOR DANIEL AND VICKI'S JOURNEY

- Dec 1
 The first Sunday in December, Daniel became the new Pastor of a Southern Baptist Mission that had started in 1963. There were 90 people in attendance. Having just completed seminary in Texas, this was Pastor Daniel's first pastorate.
- **1993** Built the North Valley Baptist Church in Columbia Falls. This was the first of two church building programs for new church plants, the other was in Kila. In the course of his years as pastor at Easthaven, planting churches in unreached areas has been Daniel's passion and vision.

Hope Pregnancy Ministries started at Easthaven with Daniel and three ladies: Twyla Klundt, Trish Goyer, and Kathy Keller. It has substantially grown, where it has a Board of Directors now. The Director, Michelle Reimer, calls Daniel the 'grandfather' of Hope Pregnancy babies. In the year of 2016, over 26 babies were born to see their potential. There are no longer abortions on demand in the Flathead Valley.

- **1997** Daniel William born July 1, 1997.
- **1999** Adrianna born May 26, 1999. Pastor Joey Gardner hired. Attendance up to 272.
- **2001** Voted to relocate and bought 10 acres on Whitefish Stage.
- **2004** With the church attendance at 400, the present church building began construction with 800 volunteers over the next 16 months. Pastor Matt Fitzwater hired.
- 2005 Moved into the new building.
- 2006 Pastor Andy McPeak hired.
- 2007 Saturday evening service (e3) added.
- **2011** The Emancipation Campaign was started to pay off the remaining church debt. By December 2014, the \$1.3 million was paid during an economic downturn in the valley. Pastor Frank Shelt hired.
- **2012** Pastor Dean Landis hired. Thompson Lakes Christian Retreat returned to Easthaven management.
- **2014** Darren Banek hired as Director of Finance and Adult Discipleship.

An Unreached People Group in South Asia is adopted with frequent teams going several times a year to share the Gospel and train up disciples. Over the years, Uganda, Czech Republic, and Ethiopia have had regular short term teams go each year. Five individuals and families have been sent as long term missionaries.

2015 Three associate staff members were hired for Middle School, High School, and College age ministries.

Plans for Glacier Bible College start to come together.

2016 Attendance at 800, a third Sunday morning service is added. Phases 1 & 2 of remodeling are completed. Church plants in Whitefish with Chris Baker and Columbia Falls with Bruce Crocket and Kyle Rosas begin.

We will continue to meet the first Friday of every month beginning with lunch starting at 12:00 and ending around 1:30. Everyone is encouraged to bring along a friend, family member, co-worker, or neighbor. It is an excellent opportunity to get acquainted, learn about what the Senior Adult Ministry and our church family has to offer, as we share the love and joy of Jesus with one another.

In 2017, we also hope to host one or two retreats at the camp allowing participants the opportunity to get away and enjoy time fellowshipping with one another while also worshipping the Lord.

Lastly, in December 2017, we will be hosting a new Senior Adult Christmas Banquet. This will surely be a special event as we highlight the accomplishments of our various links, and recognize individuals for their achievements. As you can see, 2017 will be an exciting year and I am looking forward serving each of you, while serving our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
